Men's Golf Tournament / Ladies Golf Tournament:

To be played on the Rees Jones Course at Breakers West. (\$225/per person) Transportation will be provided

Men's Tennis Tournament / Ladies Tennis Tournament:

(\$80/hour/court, \$395 minimum Tournament Fee)

Voted one of the "top 50 tennis resorts" by *Tennis Magazine*, The Breakers tennis facility offers guests 10 beautifully groomed Har-Tru courts.



International Ball:

(\$85/perperson/ min 10guests/ max 64 guests / 2 hours)

Choose from Croquet, a Palm Beach tradition, or the classic Italian lawn game of Bocce Ball. With The Breakers as a backdrop, the Activities staff will lead you through the etiquette, rules and strategies of the game before the tournament begins.



Guided Reef Tour:

(\$75/per person/ min 4 guests/ max of 40 guests / 1.5 hours)

Accompanied by a PADI Instructor, this event takes you on a reef tour of the sunken Breakers pier, you will learn the basic skills necessary to make any snorkeling excursion complete and see our indigenous fish.

Deep Sea Fishing:

(\$1,750/per boat -\$292/per person/ max 6 guests per boat / 4 hours)*

*Note: A full boat is required for this activity to be booked; a second boat may be added for an additional group of 6 guests.

You'll be fishing in Sailfish alley, the closest point to the Gulf Stream in Florida. Each 48-52 ft. fully-equipped boat holds a maximum of 6 guests, complete with a Captain and crew. Be on the lookout for Kingfish, Wahoo, Pompano, Dolphin, Amberjack and Sailfish

SSA Hosted Events on Monday, December 3, 2018:

Spouses Coffee and Tea Hour: (no charge)

Weave your way through the town of Palm Beach on this six mile trip along the Intracoastal Waterway. During a leisurely pace, adults enjoy the beauty of the island and many of its hidden treasures. The tour includes a visit to the island's iconic ice cream shop.

Eco Adventure:

(\$150/per person, min 8 guests / max 25 guests / 2 hours)

Take a leisurely stroll through nature trails where you will experience the peace and beauty of southeast Florida's subtropical flora. Enjoy this tropical coastal habitat from the water on a kayak or a paddle board. Glide along the estuary, under Burnt Bridge into the Lake Worth Lagoon and visit Munyon Island, an outlying part of the Park with a rich history. Depending on the season, you may see wildlife including manatees, dolphins, mullet, snook, rays and a variety of birds.
